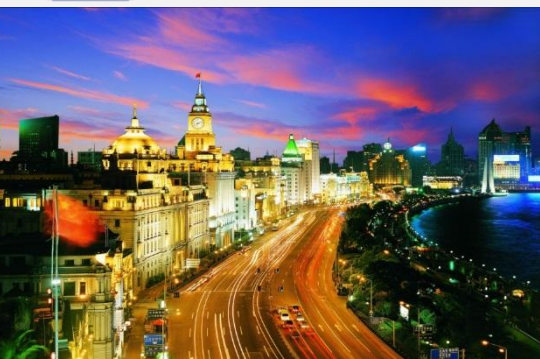

TOUR HIGHLIGHTS:

West Lake - West Lake is man-made and created after the Chinese love for garden-style parks for recreation. It's in the western suburbs, the historic center of Hangzhou. West Lake is the symbol of Hangzhou, and is considered one of the most beautiful sights in China.

Lotus Root Garden - the formal residential house at the center part connecting two gardens in east and west. In Chinese, lotus root also means "couple," so the garden implies "the husband and wife return to the life seclusion." The garden has unique design and demonstrates the wonderful oriental "romantic"

The Bund - is a waterfront area in central Shanghai. The Shanghai Bund has dozens of historical buildings, lining the Huangpu River, that once housed numerous banks and trading houses.

DAY 01 KUALA LUMPUR – SHANGHAI-HANGZHOU

Assemble at KLIA for our flight to Shanghai . Upon arrival at Shanghai International Airport, we'll meet our local guide and transfer from Shanghai to Hangzhou take dinner at the local Muslim restaurant. After dinner visit **Hangzhou West Lake**. West Lake is a freshwater lake in Hangzhou, the capital of Zhejiang province in eastern China. It is divided into five sections by three causeways. There are numerous temples, pagodas, gardens, and artificial islands within the lake. Later proceed to **Qinghi Street** . The most China's Famous old street. Than transfer back to hotel.

DAY 02 HANGZHOU

(B/L/D)

After breakfast, start the tour with transfer to **West Lake** jetty. You may enjoy the beautiful scenery of the famous West Lake by **cruise**. Then visit **Huagang Park**. A fish-watching spot in a flowering harbor with beautiful scenery. Located on a peninsula between the Inner Lake and the Small Southern Lake. After that, proceed to **LeiFeng Pagoda**. A five-storey tower with eight sides, located on Sunset Hill south of the West Lake in Hangzhou, China. Originally constructed in the year AD 975, it collapsed in 1924 but was rebuilt in 2002. After lunch, visit famous green tea village know as **Dragon Well Tea** to enjoy the Culture of Chinese tea. Then continue to the **Phoenix Mosque**. This is one of the oldest mosques in China, predated only by the Great Mosque of Guangzhou and the Great Mosque at Hangzhou. Dinner at local restaurant and transfer back to hotel.

DAY 03 HANGZHOU – SUZHOU

(B/L/D)

After breakfast, we head out to **Suzhou** by coach. After arrival Suzhou start the tour to **Jinji Lake**. Jinji Lake is a small fresh water lake located in the central part of Suzhou Industrial Park. It occupies an area of 7.18 square kilometers and its average depth is about 2.5 to 3 meters. There are two man-made islands in the lake. Later continue to visit **Humble Administrators Garden**. The beautiful waterside City of Suzhou in Jiangsu Province in South China is most famous for its elegant classical gardens. Next, will continue to **Suzhou Bird's Nest Stadium**. This is the largest multi functional stadium in Suzhou, which is also known as the twin brother of the Beijing Bird's nest. Suzhou Bird's Nest was constructed 1st before the official permission was granted to build another replica of it in Beijing which is the Beijing Bird's Nest Stadium. Lunch at local restaurant. Then proceed to **Pingjiang Old Street** - it's found on Suzhou maps as far back as the Song Dynasty (960-1279). This narrow flagstone street and the lanes extending from it are lined with old-style architecture, housing shops, tea houses, hotels and homes depicting life before motor vehicles. You can shop here for quality handicrafts, clothes and other items. Dinner at local restaurant and transfer back to hotel.

DAY 04 SUZHOU – SHANGHAI

(B/L/D)

After breakfast, proceed to the No.1 **Silk Factory** in Suzhou founded in 1926 as a state-owned factory. With this tour, firstly you can get the knowledge of the whole life of a silkworm. Later we pay a visit to **Lotus Root Garden** by boat. The Lotus Root Garden is located at No. 7, Xiaoxinqiao Lane, in the east of Suzhou. In 1963, the garden was listed as cultural relics protection unit of Suzhou City. After that **Tai Pingfang Mosque**, which is the only remaining mosque in Suzhou. The mosque holds twelve stone steles from the Ming and Qing dynasties. Transfer back to **Shanghai**. Lunch at local restaurant. After arrival Shanghai, proceed to **Nanjing Road** and **The Bund** also called Zhongshan Dong Yi Lu, with famous waterfront and regarded as the symbol of Shanghai for hundreds of years. Dinner at local restaurant and transfer back to hotel.

DAY 05 SHANGHAI

(B/L/D)

After breakfast will visit 94th floor of **Shanghai World Financial Center** (include ticket) that was planned to be the tallest building in the world when it was designed in 1997. After lunch, proceed to **Tongrentang** which is a local medical centre. Continue to the largest mosque in Shanghai - **Xiaotaoyuan Mosque** that first established in 1917, and renovated in 1925, today **Xiao Taoyuan Mosque** is a functioning mosque which also serves as the headquarters of the Shanghai Islamic Association. Lunch at local restaurant. Afterward proceed to visit **Yu Yuan Garden**. Yuyuan Garden is a famous classical garden located in Anren Jie, Shanghai. It was finished in 1577 by a government officer of the Ming Dynasty (1368-1644) named Pan Yunduan. Yu in Chinese means pleasing and satisfying, and this garden was specially built for Pan's parents as a place for them to enjoy a tranquil and happy time in their old age. Dinner and transfer back to hotel.

DAY 06 SHANGHAI – KUALA LUMPUR

(B/L)

After Breakfast enjoy shopping at **Taobaocheng** Free Market. One of the best and largest free markets in Shanghai, and a hot destination for tourist to shop for good selection of products. There are items like clothes, watches, shoes, bags, chopsticks, electronics, toys and accessories. After lunch, you'll be transferred to airport for departure flight back to Kuala Lumpur with happy memories.
