TOUR HIGHLIGHTS:

Great Wall of China - is a series of fortifications made of stone, brick, tamped earth, wood, and other materials, generally built along an east-to-west line across the historical northern borders of China in part to protect the Chinese Empire or its prototypical states against intrusions by various nomadic groups or military incursions by various warlike peoples or forces.

Forbidden City - was the Chinese imperial palace from the Ming Dynasty to the end of the Qing Dynasty. It is located in the middle of Beijing, China, and now houses the Palace Museum. For almost 500 years, it served as the home of emperors and their households, as well as the ceremonial and political center of Chinese government.

Bird's Nest Stadium - Located at the Olympic Green, the stadium cost US\$423 million. The design, which originated from the study of Chinese ceramics, implemented steel beams in order to hide supports for the retractable roof; giving the stadium the appearance of a bird's nest.

Beijing Zoo - The Beijing Zoo was built in 1906 in Qing Dynasty with an area of only 10 hectares and a few humble pavilions to house the animals. It was named as "Wansheng Garden" (Ten-Thousand Animal Garden) and officially renamed as Beijing Zoo in 1955. Now it covers an area of 86 hectares, breeding over 5000 animals in more than 450 species.

DAY 01 & 02 KUALA LUMPUR – BEIJING

(B/L/D)

Assemble at KLIA for our flight to Beijing where we catch evening flight from KLIA. Upon arrival, we'll meet our local guide and be transferred to hotel for rest. Morning, breakfast at the local Muslim restaurant before we proceed to visit the **Tiananmen Square**, the largest city square in the world, then tour **Forbidden City**, the Imperial Palace which was home to the emperors for over 500 years. Later we'll visit the famous mosque in the city, **Chao Nei Mosque** for prayer and take lunch the nearest restaurant before proceeding to shop at **Muslim Super Market** at **Niujie**. It is the only super market serving the Muslim community in Beijing. Enjoy stylish apparel at local **Silk Show Room** before pampering ourselves with **traditional free foot massage** at Chinese medicine center. Dinner will be provided at local Muslim restaurant.

DAY 03 BEIJING – THE GREAT WALL TOUR

(B/L/D)

After breakfast we will proceed with the highlight of our China tour, the climbing of the **Great Wall of China**. The Great Wall, first built in the Warring States period (475 -221 BC) as a series of earthworks erected by individual kingdoms as defense against each other and also to repel invasions from the north. The present day wall was a remnant left from the Ming dynasty. We'll make a quick stop at **Jade Center & Crystal Center** for shopping. Lunch at local Muslim restaurant near to the Great Wall and we'll visit the **Burning Cream Center** soon after. Return to city center for dinner and enjoy the famous **Chinese Acrobatic Show**.

DAY 04 BEIJING – SUMMER PALACE

(B/L/D)

We'll visit the **Summer Palace** right after breakfast. The Largest imperial garden in China, Summer Palace was first built during the Qing Emperor Qianlong's time in 1751 and was later burned down in 1860 by the French and British army. Dowager empress Cixi restored the palace for her own enjoyment and it became a favorite haunt of Cixi, who preferred it to the Forbidden City, and named it Yi He Yuan; meaning the garden of health and harmony. After lunch visit to the **Ma Dian Mosque** which is one of the renowned mosques in China with its centuries of heritage. We'll Shopping at **Fresh Water Pearl Centre** before we enjoy the breathtaking tea during the **Tea Ceremony at the Tea House**. Visit **Bamboo Charcoal Shop**.

DAY 05 BEIJING – TIANJIN – BEIJING

After breakfast, we head out to **Tianjin** on coach. Tianjin, which means Port to Heavenly Capital, is 130 kilometers southeast of Beijing, serving as Beijing's gateway to the Bohai Sea. People started to settle in Tianjin in the Song Dynasty (960-1279A.D) and by the 15th century it had become a garrison town enclosed by walls. After several decades of development, Tianjin is now one of China's leading manufacturing and commercial centers. We'll visit the famous **Food Street and the Culture Street** of Tianjin.

DAY 06 & 07 BEIJING – OLYMPIC TOUR – KUALA LUMPUR

After breakfast, check out hotel. Transfer to **Beijing Zoo**. Beijing Zoo has rare Chinese animals, such as the Giant Panda, the Golden Monkey, the Red Panda, Sichuan golden monkey, Manchurian tigers, yaks from Tibet, enormous sea turtles and also a strong selection from around the world - Indian elephants, zebras and giraffes from Africa - the list of animals could be very long. Take a short visit to Beijing's **Olympic Village**. Olympic Village famous for its **Bird's Nest Stadium and Aquatic Water Cube Stadium**, boast an architectural marvel of modern days engineering. Then, take lunch at nearest area and continue with the itinerary which is shopping at **Hongqiao market** and **Xiushui Street**. Then, we will get the dinner at local Muslim restaurant. You'll be getting on your transfer coach to the airport at least two hours before we catch the midnight flight. Hope you'll have a safe journey home!
