TOUR HIGHLIGHTS:

Nami Island - is a place where romances loom throughout the year with beautiful seasonal background.

Mt. Soraksan National Park - Also referred to as Seolsan and Seolbongsan, the mountain was named Seorak because the snow would not melt for a long time keeping the rocks in a permanent state of white.

DAY 01 & 02 KUALA LUMPUR – INCHEON – NAMISEOM – MT. SORAK (L/D)

Assemble at KLIA for our flight to Incheon. Scheduled flight is in the morning and hot meals provided onboard. Upon arrival, you'll be greeted by our friendly local representative, which will gives us a wonderful surprise onboard the **Seagull Cruise** enroute to **Wolmido Island**. We will continue on with our itinerary to **Incheon China Town, Petite France**, and the ever so popular “ **Nami Island** ” (**Namiseom**) and **Chuncheon Myeongdong**.

DAY 03 MT. SORAK – JEONGDONGJIN (B/L/D)

After breakfast, we will proceed with today's itinerary with nature walk around **Mt. Seoraksan**. We'll visit **Seoraksan National Park (Shinheungsa Temple)** which houses The Bronze Buddha Statue. Later we continue to **Teddy Bear Farm** which offers a glimpse into the unique lifestyle of Sokcho through teddy bears: teddy bears are displayed mountain-climbing, skiing, playing golf, riding a boat from Abai Village to downtown, working hard on a squid fishing boat, sun tanning, or even defending the country. Continur visit to **Daepohang Fish Market**. At Daepohang Port it is said that the Seorak Mountains and the East Sea are gifts from nature. The port is filled with raw fish restaurants and a live fish market containing eel, flatfish, flounder, yellowtail, and plethora of other high-end seafood. For raw fish lovers that are in the Sokcho area, Daepohang Port is the place to be. After that, proceed to **Naksansa Temple** and last but not least to coastal city of **Jeongdongjin**. We take a ride on “**The Jeongdongjin Sunrise Tourist Train**” and if we're lucky, we'll be able to catch the beautiful sunset on a romantic evening.

DAY 04 EVERLAND - SEOUL (B/D)

On the fourth day of your Korean adventure, we'll spend some quality time at the ever famous **Everland** (Day Pass Included - Lunch at your own expenses), a full-filled theme park to enjoy thrilling rides and a galore of lively entertainment. Later in the evening, we'll transfer you to the heart and capital city of **South Korea, Seoul**. Experience one of a kind shopping retreat at **Dongdaemun Market**, a large commercial district comprised of traditional markets and shopping centers that covers the entire area around Dongdaemun (Gate), a prominent landmark in Korea. It is Korea's largest wholesale and retail shopping district featuring 26 shopping malls, 30,000 speciality shops, and 50,000 manufacturers. All kinds of goods can be found here including silks and fabric, clothes, shoes and accessories, electronics, leather goods, sporting goods, office supplies, pet products and toys.

DAY 05 SEOUL CITY TOUR (B/L/D)

After breakfast, we will visit **Deoksugeum Palace**, which also houses an art museum, forested gardens, and a statue of King Sejong the Great at **Deoksugung**. Later we proceed to **National Ginseng Shop, Herbal Shop**, and **Songhak Laver Museum** in which you'll be able to wear **Hanbok, Korea Traditional Costume**. Afterward, we will go on a shopping spree at **The Face Shop, Amethyst Factory**, Myeongdong & Duty Free, and the local product shops.
