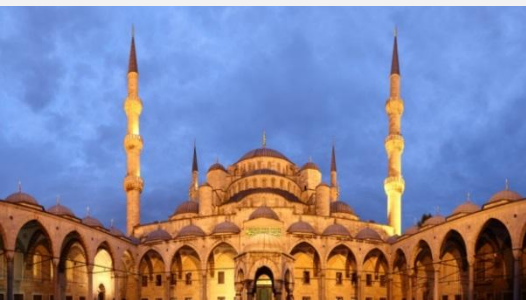

TOUR HIGHLIGHTS:

Sultan Ahmed Mosque (The "Blue Mosque" Of Istanbul) - The cascading domes and six slender minarets dominate the skyline of Istanbul.

Hierapolis - Pamukkale - Pamukkale (Cotton Palace) & Hierapolis is a World Heritage Site and popular tourist destination.

Cappadocia – The highlight of any tour to Turkey & unique landscape evolved from erosion of the ash sedimentation by wind, sun, rain and snow, sculpting the land into countless strangely shaped pillars, cones and "fairy chimneys". The moonscape region of cappadocia, southeast of Ankara, is most famous for unique geological features called fairy chimneys.

Mevlana Museum – In the museum there are properties belonging to Mevlana and other dervishes as well as valuable samples of hand-painted kerchiefs, handwritings, ornaments, wooden works of art and instruments of the Mevlevi music, carpets and pileless carpets

Day 1: Kuala Lumpur -Istanbul –Bursa

(L/D)

Arrive at Ataturk International Airport in Istanbul. Welcome and assist by our English speaking tour guide., we visit Blue Mosque, famous for its blue tiles and unique with its 6 minarets built in the name of Sultan Ahmet. Then Hippodrome – where chariot races and gladiator sports used to take place visit the marvelous oriental **Topkapi Palace**. Topkapi Palace was the residence of Ottoman sultans for almost four centuries and is Istanbul's premier must-see attraction. Photo stop for **St. Sophia** from outside. Then we depart to Eskihsar and embark on a ferryboat to **Yalova**, enjoying the countryside followed by a drive to **Bursa**, (around 2,5 hours). Upon arrive to Bursa check in hotel.

Day 2: Bursa - Kusadasi

(B/L/D)

After breakfast at hotel in Bursa, we will visit **Bursa Grand Mosque** or **Ulu Cami**. Built in the Seljuk style, it was ordered by the Ottoman Sultan Bayezid I and built between 1396 and 1399. The mosque has 20 domes and 2 minarets. Later proceed to **Green Mausoleum** which is a mausoleum of the fifth Ottoman Sultan, Mehmed I, and the famous **Silk Market** where time will be allocated to shop for local souvenirs. Travel to Kusadasi for overnight stay.

Day 3 Kusadasi – Selcuk - Pamukkale

(B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel. Set off for **Selcuk** where you will explore **Ephesus**, one of the largest archaeological sites in existence. You will find the structures such as the Library of Celsius, Hadrian Temple, Mable Street and Agora. Ephesus is also one of the 7 Churches of Revelation and holds the House of Virgin Mary. Visit beautiful **Isabey Mosque**, is a example of Seljuk Turkish architecture in an atmospheric location. It is the oldest known example of a Turkish mosque with a courtyard. Then visit **leather shop** for live fashion show. Then we continue to **Pamukkale**. We will tour the **Antique City of Hierapolis** where Calcereous hot springs descending over cliffs have created fascinating travertines in the form of white terrace and basins – **Cotton Castle, a UNESCO World Heritage Site**. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Pamukkale.

Day 4 Pamukkale – Konya –Cappadocia

(B/L/D)

After breakfast, travel to **Cappadocia** via **Konya**, the famous old capital of the Selcuk Turks. We will visit to **Mevlana Museum**, is the mausoleum of Jalal ad-Din Muhammad Rumi, a Persian Sufi mystic also known as Mevlāna or Rumi. It was also the dervish lodge of the Mevlevi order, better known as the whirling dervishes located in Konya. Then, proceed to **Cappadocia** which is considered to be one of the natural wonders of the world with its surrealistic geological creation A stop will be made at **Sultanhani Caravanserai**, an outstanding example of the Inns used by traders during the Silk Road and lunch will be served in caravanserai. Dinner and overnight at hotel in **Cappadocia**.

Day 5 Cappadocia

(B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel. Enjoy full tour of the **Cappadocia** which boasts a unique landscape sculpted by the wind, sun, rain & show. Explore **Kaymakli Underground City**, one of the largest underground cities in Turkey, said to have existed since the Hittite Period. Continue with **Goreme Open Air Meseum**, a compound comprising 29 rick-cut churches, including some that date back to the 6th century. Next, proceed to **Uçhisar**, an old village comprising snakk dwellings carved into a massive rock. Thereafter, visit a traditional handmade **Carpet Factory and showroom**. Experience of an Avanos pottery demonstration at **Avanos Village**. Dinner and overnight at hotel.

Day 6 Cappadocia – Ankara – Bolu

(B/L/D)

After breakfast, depart for Ankara, capital of Turkey. Visit **Ataturk Mausoleum**, the final resting place of Mustafa Kemal Ataturk, who was regarded as the father of modern Turkey. Thereafter, proceed to **Bolu** for overnight stay.

Day 7 Bolu - Istanbul

(B/L/D)

After breakfast, back to **Istanbul**. Upon arrival to Istanbul, we will have lunch at local restaurant. One of the best ways to get a feel for Istanbul is to take a cruise on the legendary Bosphorus. Begin the tour with a brief visit to the 17th century **Spice Bazaar**, one of Istanbul's most colorful and bustling attractions. Then hop aboard your ferry for a **cruise along the Bosphorus**, and then finally drop to the 500year old **Grand Bazaar** - a maze of over 4,000 stalls and shops selling leather goods, jewellery, handicrafts, ceramics, Turkish coffee and other local products. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Istanbul.

Day 8 Istanbul – Kuala Lumpur

(B/MOB)

After breakfast. Spend time at leisure before transfer to airport.

Day 9 Arrive in Kuala Lumpur
