**Blagaj** – Tekke on the Buna in Blagaj is an important monument of the early Ottoman period in Bosnia and Herzegovina. It is a place where, by special ritual, the dervishes performed – and perform today – Zikr (praising God).

**Diocletian's Palace** - Considered to be one of the most imposing Roman ruins, Diocletian's palace is certainly the main attraction of the city of Split, Croatia. These ruins are some of the most valuable surviving buildings of the Roman era on the Adriatic coast.

### DEPARTURE DATE

09 SEP – 18 SEP 2017

**DAY 01 (09 SEP) KUALA LUMPUR – ISTANBUL - SARAJEVO (MOB)**  
Assemble at KLIA for your departure flight to Sarajevo, Bosnia-Herzegovina.

**DAY 02 (10 SEP) SARAJEVO (L/D)**  
Arrival at fascinating capital city Sarajevo. You will be welcomed and assisted at the airport. Due to its rich religious and cultural history, Sarajevo is often called the Jerusalem of Europe. The city contains synagogues, mosques, orthodox as well as Catholic churches - all in one city. In 1914 the city was the site of the assassination of Archduke Franz Ferdinand which prompted the start of the First World War. Your Local Specialist will show you the important sights. Today sightseeing includes the **Tunnel of Hope Museum**. This Tunnel was the only way to go in and out of Sarajevo during the 1992-95 war siege of the city. We will continue walking tour to **Bascarsija** (Old Town), **Latin Bridge**, where the Austro Hungarian Archduke was assassinated which initiated the first world war. Continue to **Brusa Bezistan**, the roofed market place. Next view the **Ghazi Husrev-Bey Mosque** built in 1530 during the Ottoman Empire, and **Vijecnica** – the town hall built in the Austro-Hungarian period. Lunch at local restaurant and Dinner at hotel.

**DAY 03 (11 SEP) SARAJEVO - MOSTAR- BLAGAJ - NEUM (B/L/D)**  
Today leave Sarajevo and travel through dramatic mountainous scenery to Mostar. Upon arrival in Mostar, we will begin with the city tour ad visit **Karadzooz-Bey Mosque** and walk around the **Old Town** and **Old Bridge** being recognised as the UNESCO world cultural heritage site. Continue to **Blagaj** to visit the oldest **Tekke** in Bosnia from XV century. Lunch at local restaurant. Proceed to Neum for overnight stay.

**DAY 04 (12 SEP) NEUM – DUBRONIK - NEUM (B/L/D)**  
After breakfast, travel to the Dalmatian coast and the spectacular medieval city of **Dubrovnik**. Enjoy a sightseeing walking tour of the main sights includes the **Cathedral, Rector's Palace, Franciscan Monastery, Clock Tower, Orlando's Columns and Sponze Palace**. Seafood lunch at Old City and later prayer in the Masjid. Some free time to enjoy the city before heading back to Neum. Dinner at the hotel and overnight at Neum.

**DAY 05 (13 SEP) NEUM – SPLIT (B/L/D)**  
Early morning, travel north along the spectacular Adriatic coast, past old fishing villages and new resorts, to **Split**. Enjoy a walking tour around the historic inner city, built around the Roman Emperor Diocletian's Palace, a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage Site. See the remnants of Split's Roman heritage, **Diocletian's Palace**. Lunch at local restaurant and enjoy free time exploring the city on your own before we have dinner in the hotel.

**DAY 06 (14 SEP) SPLIT – PLITVICE - ZAGREB (B/L/D)**  
This morning travel to the forested **National Park of Plitvice**. Admire the breathtaking waterfalls and lakes of this spectacular UNESCO World Heritage Site on your walking tour. See lakes of crystal-clear water in many colourful shades of green, grey and blue which are linked by spectacular waterfalls. This evening arrive at your hotel in Zagreb and enjoy dinner at the hotel.

**DAY 07 (15 SEP) ZAGREB - LJUBLJANA (B/L/D)**  
After breakfast, sightseeing of Old and New Delhi covering **India Gate, Jamia Mosque, Lakshmi Narayan Temple** (Birla Temple), **Lotus Temple, Raj Ghat** (Cremation Place of Father of Nation Mahatma Gandhi), **drive past Red Fort, Qutab Minar, President's Palace, Parliament House, Government Buildings** etc. Late evening transfer to International Airport for flight back home with great memories.

**DAY 08 (16 SEP) LJUBLJANA – BLED – ZAGREB (B/L/D)**  
After breakfast, we will stroll through the Old Town, see the old & new markets and pass by the Romanesque, Gothic and Renaissance buildings. We will see the famous **Triple Bridge** and finish the tour at **Baroque Robba Fountain**. After lunch, proceed to Bled. **Bled** is a glacial lake and Europe's adventure playground. Dinner & overnight stay in Zagreb.

**DAY 09/10 (17/18 SEP) ZAGREB – ISTANBUL – KUALA LUMPUR (B/MOB)**  
Breakfast at hotel. Free at own leisure till time to transfer to airport for your departure flight to Kuala Lumpur with wonderful memories.
