### DAY 1 KUALA LUMPUR - JEDDAH - ISTANBUL

(MOB)

Assemble and meet our Tour Manager at KLIA. Accompany by our Tour Manager, board a night flight to Istanbul via Jeddah.

### DAY 2 ARRIVE ISTANBUL - BURSA

(L/D)

Upon arrival Istanbul, visit **Roman Hippodrome** where horse chariot races and events were held. Proceed to visit the **Blue Mosque-Sultan Ahmet Mosque**. Then visit **Topkapi Palace** – the seat of the Ottoman Empire, after it shifted its capital from Bursa to Istanbul. It is today, a museum palace with a wide collection of Kitchen wares and Porcelains, Treasures, Royal Antiques, Courtyards, Holy Relics etc. After lunch, depart to Eskişehir and embark on a ferryboat to Yalova enjoying the countryside drive to Bursa (around 2.5 hours). Check-in hotel in Bursa for dinner and overnight in Tiara Thermal Hotel 4\* or similar.

### DAY 3 BURSA - KUSADASI

(B/L/D)

Following breakfast, we will visit Grand Mosque, Green Mosque, Green Mausoleum and the Silk Market where time will be allocated to shop for local souvenirs. After lunch, drive to Kusadasi. Visit **Turkish Delight & Olive Oil Outlet** center. Free time for shopping. Dinner and overnight in Marina Hotel 4\* or similar.

### DAY 4 KUSADASI - PAMUKKALE

(B/L/D)

Following breakfast, we drive to Selçuk to visit **Ephesus** as well as viewing one of the Seven Churches of Revelation, the Temple of Artemis (One of the Seven Wonders of Antiquity) and the Basilica of St. John from a distance, followed by lunch in the township of Selçuk. After lunch we will visit the famous local production center for leather garments whereby after a live Fashion Show time will be allocated for shopping. Drive to **Pamukkale, which known as Cotton Castle**. Visit Pamukkale, where Calcareous hot springs descending over cliffs have created fascinating travertines in the form of white terrace and basins. Free time for walking on terraces. Then visit the ruins of **Ancient City of Hierapolis**. Enjoy Thermal Spa at hotel. Dinner and overnight in Tripolis Hotel 4\* or similar.

### DAY 5 PAMUKKALE - KONYA - CAPPADOCIA

(B/L/D)

Following breakfast, we will drive to Cappadocia. Lunch will be enroute before arriving in Konya. Konya was the center of the Seljuk Empire as well as the city of Mevlana and his Whirling Dervishes. After visiting **the Mevlana Museum**, we will continue to Cappadocia Cappadocia which is considered to be one of the natural wonders of the world with its surrealistic geological creation. Visit **Oresin Caravanserai**, an 13th century outstanding example of the Inns used by traders during the Silk Road. Dinner and overnight in **Cave Hotel** Cappadocia, Best Western Cave Hotel 4\* or similar.

### DAY 6 CAPPADOCIA

(B/L/D)

Today we visit one of the **Underground City** where early Christians lived secretly in order to survive and keep their faith. Picture stops will be given at the **Valley of the Birds** and at the foot of the **Uchisar Castle**. Lunch will be at Avanos Village followed by the famous local pottery work shop. Then visit **Dervent Valley & Pasabag Valley** which has unique volcanic formations. Stop by local carpet weaving cooperative to see hand-made Turkish carpets. Dinner and overnight in Best Western Cave Hotel 4\* or similar.

### DAY 7 CAPPADOCIA - ANKARA - BOLU

(B/L/D)

Depart for Ankara, the capital of Turkey. Visit **Salt Lake** on the way. After lunch, visit the **Ataturk Mausoleum** – the final resting place of Mustafa Kemal Atatürk – Father of modern Turkey. The architecture of the mausoleum is a mix of different styles that represent the various Anatolian civilizations. Transfer to Bolu for dinner and overnight in Soylu Hotel 4\* or similar.

### DAY 8 BOLU - ISTANBUL

(B/L/D)

After breakfast at hotel, drive to Istanbul. Upon arrival have lunch in local restaurant. Then visit **Tulip Garden**. The tulips begin to bloom around the end of March or beginning of April, depending on the weather. They bloom for several weeks and may delight the eye and the spirit for nearly a month. The tulip is one of Istanbul's traditional symbols. Dinner and overnight in Grand Anka Hotel 4\* or similar.

### DAY 9/10 ISTANBUL - JEDDAH - KUALA LUMPUR

(B/MOB)

Free until transfer time. Then, transfer to airport to catch your flight back to Kuala Lumpur via Jeddah. Home sweet home!
